

Terrence Coffey's VALLEY OF THE KINGS is the third novel of ancient Egypt I have read recently, and I am once again most impressed by the work of an author. Coffey treats one of the most popular and misunderstood periods of Egyptian history, the so-called "Amarna Revolution." This was in many ways a reactionary movement that remains clouded in mystery and thus creates a number of problems as we attempt to make sense of it. Unfortunately for

Egyptologists and historians, with the restoration of the cult of Amun-Ra came concerted efforts to remove all record of the heretical pharaoh, Akhenaten, and even the brief reigns of his successors. Thus, enigmas abound. Once again I find myself wishing I could offer 4.5 stars. Perhaps will some day provide us with the option to count beyond the decimal point. This is a good book, and I certainly recommend it. The narrative flows smoothly, and it is a definite "page-turner." The pacing is excellent for the plot line as it unfolds chronologically. I like a number of the author's touches, particularly: (1) Ay as the ultimate manipulator -- de facto assassin of Amenhotep III, likely assassin of Nefertiti, and implicated conspirator in the chariot "accident" of Tut; (2) the intrigues amongst the Mitanni and Hittites, who are also given very "cereal" characterizations; (3) the eventual ruthlessness of Akhenaten, who was indeed a fanatic and probably had plenty of blood on his hands. This is a work of fiction, and the author is certainly entitled to take liberties "all the more so, since we often do not know what actually happened. We might perhaps begin with "King Tut," the celebrated Tutankhamen.
