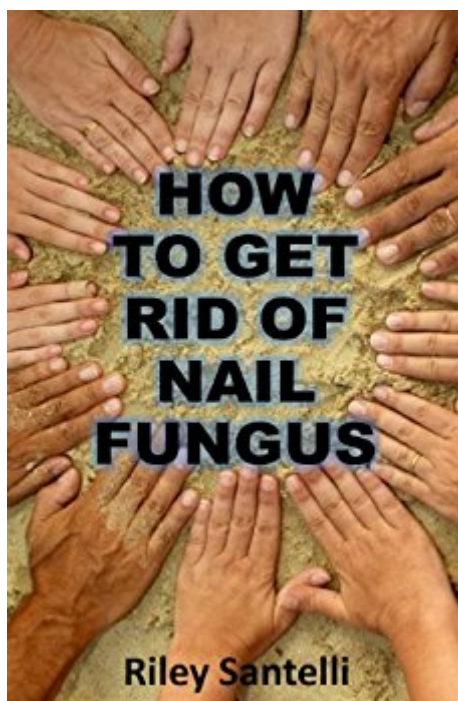

and the book is informational only. It discusses the causes, symptoms and treatment: home remedies, diet, and medical. Particularly important is the chapter on how to prevent getting a fungus. This is a practical and easy to understand guide to a common medical problem.

How to Get Rid of Nail Fungus is a short but to-the-point book about the causes, symptoms and treatments of nail fungus on both the toe and fingernails. It gives just the right amount of information anyone could ask for when researching this topic: what is nail fungus, what causes it, how do I treat it if I can't get to a doctor, what do I use when I do get to the doctor, and how do I prevent it from happening in the first place? All these questions get answered with a straightforward tone, a few succinct chapters, and a nice section on home remedies for treating nail fungus once it's diagnosed. The home remedies section was particularly enlightening, as it taught me about the multiple uses for apple cider vinegar, Listerine, and tea tree oil.
