

Years ago our church in another state supported Brother Grings daughter and son-in-law, Darrell and Louise Champlin, so we were familiar with some of the stories of his life. This book is more geared to children than his autobiography, so I am reading it to our grandchildren, and they are fascinated by the life of this devoted Christian.

This is the biography of Herbert Grings who went to Congo in the early 1900's. Jan Van Hee did a fantastic job of describing the people, blessings, and challenges of missionary work in Africa. This book will help you understand a missionary's heart and call to serve God.
