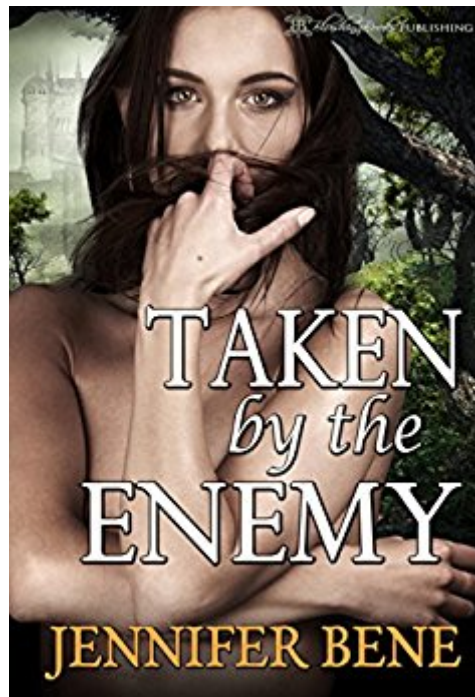

I was drawn into this dark erotic story with a corrupt government system, evil men controlling people, a system that exiled people from the city without a fair trial, leaving them to die. People inside the city were told those that were exiled were no more than wild animals. Emmie is being forced into a marriage to a sadistic man and flees the city to the forest, but dangers lurk with wild animals. Saved from a wild boar and captured by exiled warriors is like jumping from the frying pan into the fire. The plot kept me captivated and the pages turning with the resourcefulness of those in the village that had been rescued after being exiled. There are rules and order in the camp, and everyone is expected to pull their weight. Emmie is in for a rude awakening as she is belligerent, mouthy and has to learn a new way of life. From the village to the city, this story will take the reader on a roller coaster ride that is intense and raw, including rape, dubious consent, coarse language, spankings, anal play, but it offers a dark story that also has loyalty, determinations, survival and love stories too.

This book does contain explicit sexual content and violence and is not for the easily offended. Emmie leaves her sheltered life by escaping into the woods that surround her walled city to avoid a arranged marriage. She quickly finds herself in trouble in the woods only to found by a group of people that have been exiled from the city. People she has been taught her life to fear. Lucian quickly reinforces those fears when his group saves her from a Boar attack and takes her to their remote village. Emmie's pride and stubborn ways soon have her butting heads with nearly everyone, especially Lucian who has decided to make her his own using whatever means he has to in order to get her under control. The book is very well written and although contains explicit sex scenes and violence was a enjoyable read. So much so that I had to read it one day as I was so hooked on what was going to happen next. There are many well developed characters that add to the story. A highly recommended dark erotic book.

This was my first time reading this author and even though it had erotica in it, it wasn't anything heavy. It's a good story of a young woman who becomes involved in a rebellion to overthrow her autocratic, tyrannical fathers' rule. Emeline Daniau escapes from the gated city that has become her prison, only to be captured by exiled people outside the city, living in a forced socialistic state. Where reading and writing is uncommon and community manual labor is mandatory. Exiles come together to form a Village with some semblance of safety and peace. Ms. Bene conveys perfectly how the exiled ones sacrifice for each other, protecting one another unconditionally. I loved Emeline Daniau (Emmie)...loved her strength, wisdom and stubbornness. She's a hurricane! I loved her up until she began excusing Lucien's behavior (the male protagonist)... and his public punishments of her. And even though I understand WHY he must do what he does, I didn't like that Emmie got "turned on" by it. It didn't fit her fiery, spitfire personality. I don't mind erotic stories where spanking takes place...if it's mutual. But when the gal is being publicly punished because she broke a rule...that's a whole 'nother ballgame. Anyway, I liked how Emmie comes to realize how sheltered her life had become before her escape. She learns how complicated people and situations are...or can be. The downside of this story is: What year is it? Is it a futuristic world?? There's no TV or radio, yet color photographs and camera's are mentioned...as well as newspapers. But, hey Ms. Bene...lend us a clue here?

Ms. Bene has done it again! She took me on the most exciting, terrifying and satisfying rollercoaster ride with *Taken by the Enemy*. Just reading the blurb, I knew the book would be full of dark excitement and right out of the gate, I was hooked and I couldn't stop reading until I finished. I lost sleep over this freaking book! This is not a wine and roses romance, so if that is what you are looking for, I'd steer clear. But if you are looking for a well written, emotional rollercoaster full of flawed characters who you are rooting for one minute and ready to kill the next, this is the book for you. The story had a very satisfying ending with the true bad guys getting everything they deserved.

This story is set in the future where Emmie the daughter of a rich ruler is escaping her fate of marriage to a sadistic husband. Over the safe city walls she becomes entangled in the machinations of The Exiles from the ruler. Emmie's new fate is to blend in with her new existence, harsh though it is by obedience and submission to the leader Lucian. However, their relationship doesn't go as planned as others see her as an intruder and a negotiating tool to return to the City. This is a fast-paced pager-turner not only about the relationship between Emmie and Lucian but about corruption and the harsh realities of life whether it's privileged or the edge of civilisation.
